At R&S United Health Training Center, we value the power of recommendations from our students! If you're already enrolled in our phlebotomy program, you can participate in our **Referral Program** and earn cash rewards that will be applied directly to your tuition.

How the Referral Program Works:

1. **Refer a New Student**

If you're currently enrolled in our phlebotomy course, you can refer a friend, family member, or colleague to the program. Once they enroll and complete their first payment, you'll receive a referral bonus!

2. **Earn Cash Compensation Toward Your Tuition**

For each successful referral, you will receive **\$50** applied toward your remaining tuition balance. You can refer as many new students as you'd like—there's no limit to how much you can earn!

3. **How to Refer:**

- Have the referred student mention your name during their enrollment process or on the application form.
 - They must complete their enrollment and make their first payment for you to qualify for the referral bonus.
 - We will notify you once your referral is confirmed, and the referral bonus will be applied to your tuition.

Program Rules:

- You must be currently enrolled in the phlebotomy program to be eligible for the referral bonus.
 - The referred student must successfully enroll and make their first tuition payment for the referral to be valid.
 - The referral bonus will be credited directly toward your remaining tuition balance. It cannot be redeemed for cash or used for other expenses outside the program.
 - There is no limit to the number of referrals you can make. Each valid referral earns a \$50 credit.

Additional Benefits:

- **Multiple Referrals:** Refer multiple students and earn more! For example:
 - 1 referral = \$50

- 2 referrals = \$100
 - 5 referrals = \$250, and so on.
